Subject: Academic Intervention Service (AIS) for 2023-2024

Each school year, districts must develop a policy or review the existing policy for providing Academic Intervention Services (AIS).

For the 2023-2024 school year, we will consider multiple-measures of student performance to decide which students shall receive AIS. Our procedure will be applied uniformly and equitably at each grade level. These multiple measures may include, but are not limited to, the following:

1) Developmental reading assessments for grades K-6;

2) New York State English as a Second Language Achievement Test (NYSESLAT);

3) Benchmark and lesson-embedded assessments for reading and math in grades K-6 based on teacher designed and selected assessments;

4) Common formative assessments that provide information about students' skills;

5) Unit and lesson assessments for ELA, mathematics, science, social studies and Languages Other than English (LOTE) for grades 7-8; and/or

6) Results of psychoeducational evaluations based on a variety of assessments and inventories.

The following services will be provided to a student receiving AIS: monitoring of academic progress by classroom teacher, individual/small group AIS instruction, inclusion in an ability grouped class, social services by district staff as appropriate. Parents will be notified that students will receive an intervention based on the level of need. The progress made through these interventions will be monitored by RTI and/or AIS team members and communicated with parents by the classroom teacher and/or on report cards.
