A. <u>ADOPTION OF THE 2022-2023 BUDGET AND PURCHASE BUSES & VEHICLE PROPOSITIONS</u> RESOLUTION 27-4-2022

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Cherry Valley-Springfield Central School District, does hereby adopt the budget, in the amount of \$14,211,463, for the 2022-2023 school year.

RESOLUTION 28-4-2022

Shall the Board of Education be authorized to purchase two (diesel) school buses - sixty-five passengers- with the total cost not to exceed \$232,000? The source of the funds shall be a tax upon the taxable property of the District to be levied and collected in annual installments in such years and in such amounts as may be determined by the Board of Education.

RESOLUTION 29-4-2022

Shall the Board of Education be authorized to purchase one seven passenger vehicle with the total cost not to exceed \$45,000? The source of the funds shall be a tax upon the taxable property of the District to be levied and collected in annual installments in such years and in such amounts as may be determined by the Board of Education.

(Note - the Library Proposition was approved at the March 17, 2022 Board of Education Meeting.) RESOLUTION 4-3-2022

Pursuant to Education Law, Section 259, shall the Board of Education of the Cherry Valley-Springfield Central School District be authorized to levy and collect an annual tax, year after year, separate and apart from the annual school district budget, in the amount of \$60,000, of which \$30,000 shall be paid to Cherry Valley Memorial Library and \$30,000 will be paid to Springfield Library for the support and maintenance of the libraries? With this appropriated amount to be the annual appropriation until thereafter modified by a future vote of the electors of the Cherry Valley-Springfield Central School District.
