- Have an overall math average of **at least 85**
- Not have any Cherry Valley – Springfield Code of Conduct violations

To be considered an active member (maintain membership) you must meet the following requirements:

- Attend the induction ceremony Tuesday, February 13, 2018 at 6pm
- Tutor middle school math students during Office Hours, at least two times per quarter
- Participate in at least one community service project per year
- Attend at least 80% of MHS meetings, to be held the fourth Monday of every month
- Uphold the Cherry Valley-Springfield Code of Conduct
