Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Tabor.

President Tabor led the Board and audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Two students spoke about their volunteering experiences; what they did to volunteer, what they got out of volunteering and what their future plans include. Miss Lusk spoke about the successful hat & mitten drive that was held. Mrs. Georgi spoke about the upcoming 3-8 testing, TCI training for the ready to learn room staff and meetings held with probation departments from Otsego and Montgomery County. Mrs. Wright spoke about celebrating the 100th day of school, Dr. Suess's birthday and the upcoming PARP Family Night on March 22. Mrs. Wright also spoke about the upcoming conferences on March 24, attending a think tank with Mrs. Gage, being short on substitutes, and she also gave an update on the completed observations.
