Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by President Tabor.

President Tabor led the Board and audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Five students shared their experiences with volunteering, what they got out of it and their future plans. Four students requested permission to play football at Cooperstown CSD. Mrs. Georgi spoke about wrapping up meetings and the office being busy. Mrs. Wright's shared information regarding the PARP Goodies with Grownups event, thank you's to various staff members, field trip events were reviewed and graduations to be held for PreK - Wed. June 22 and 6th grade - Thurs. June 23 both at 9 AM. Mrs. Wright also spoke about the upcoming enrollment numbers for PreK and the summer professional development that will be held in July and August. Mr. Keane spoke about the regents exams currently being held, Class Night to be held in the Auditorium and Graduation at the Opera House at 11:00.

President Tabor thanked Mr. Lennebacker and Ms. Lusk, student representative, for their service to the district. Unfortunately, Ms. Lusk was not present.

Correspondence Received – A. Aramini spoke about an email she received regarding the toilet situation.

Superintendent Snyder reviewed the budget passing vote results from May 17th - Budget 192-66, Buses 178-78, Vehicle 187-70, Libraries 162-95 and Board Member, Erin Seeley 216 votes. Ms. Snyder spoke about the clay target league, the transportation advisory service Q & A, and a second Diversity, Equity, & Inclusion meeting was held but there are still no real details from State Ed. on how to proceed. Superintendent Snyder then reviewed the funding for the CRRSA and ARP Grants. Ms. Snyder reviewed hiring needs for the 22-23 school year. Discussion was held regarding metal detectors and school safety. Discussion was held regarding the building project and the Building Committee. Mrs. Urban secured a \$10,000 grant for literacy training. The School Based Health Center is looking to be a \$500,000 project to have the space ready with sewer, electric and heating. Professional development will be held throughout the summer months. The softball and baseball fields will be worked on during the summer. It is planned that the goals for the Board of Education will be reviewed at the July 7th meeting. The 22-23 school year board meeting schedule was discussed and a possible Board retreat in the fall.

President Tabor recognized the visitors and a parent shared her concern regarding the timing for her child to receive services.
